Summer 2024 Staff Packing List

Please Bring:

- Sleeping Bag
- □ Bedding pillow, blanket, fitted sheet
- Laundry Bag
- □ Shampoo, conditioner, soap, body wash
- Deodorant
- □ Toothbrush, toothpaste
- □ 2 towels (1 beach, 1 shower)
- □ Flashlight and/or headlamp with extra batteries
- Sunglasses
- □ Sunscreen for daily, constant use (minimum SPF 15)
- □ Chapstick
- □ Reusable water bottle
- Swim suit (sporty and functional, not bikini or speedo style)
- Khaki pants/shorts for check-in and check-out days
- □ 6-8 t-shirts, 1-2 long-sleeves
- More socks and underwear than you think you will need
- 3-4 pairs of jeans or similar rugged pants
- □ 5-6 pairs of shorts
- 2-3 sweatshirts (preferably hooded)
- □ Warm jacket
- Waterproof raincoat with hood or poncho
- 2 pairs of shoes (no slides or flipflops)
 - Sturdy tennis shoes
 - Sandals with a back strap (i.e. chacos or tevas)
- Pajamas plan for cool and hot nights, temps vary throughout the summer
- Notebook and pens
- □ Backpack for day to day use
- □ Wrist watch
- □ Alarm clock
- □ Liquid detergent and dryer sheets (please avoid detergent pods)

Optional Items:

- □ Travel games, cards, activity books, fidgets (for campers and you)
- Musical instruments
- □ Costumes (to create Camp Magic!)
- Stuffed animal or comfort item (just because)
- □ Pictures (of home, friends, family)
- □ Non-aerosol insect repellant
- Cabin decorations
- String lights, fairy lights, or a lamp for the cabin
- Cultural items from home
- Storage bins
- □ Books
- Journal
- Arts and crafts supplies
- Small fan for your bunk

Note: camp can be hard on clothes and belongings. Valuable items should stay home. It is recommended you bring clothes you are comfortable with getting dirty and come prepared to do laundry once a week.

Leave at home:

- Drugs/alcohol
- Vapes/e-cigarettes
- Clothing with explicit words, pictures, or alcohol logos
- Books with inappropriate content
- Expensive jewelry, watches, clothing
- Slides/flip-flops
- Sentimental items
- Hair straighteners, hair curlers
- Pets
- · Knives, weapons
- Food items with the intent to be shared with campers (we are not allowed to give campers food unless it is from the camp kitchen.
 Food should also not be stored in cabins as it invites small critters in that will be difficult to get out.)
